

Community group questions
Revelation 19:11-21

Opening question: What is one of the more adventurous things you have done?

Scripture study

- Read Revelation 19:11-13. What does John see and how is the rider described? How is this similar and different to Jesus' entry into Jerusalem in Matthew 21:1-11? Why is it hard for some to see Jesus as judge? But why must he judge evil? How would these verses encourage the church in John's day and what is the word for us as well?
- Read Revelation 19:14-16. Who is following Jesus and how are they pictured (see 19:8)? What is the significance of the order of verses 11-16 with what comes next in 17-21? How does Second Corinthians 2:14 shed more light on the scene here in Revelation 19? What difference does it make in your walk with Christ knowing He wins in the end?
- Read 19:17-21. What victory is won? How is this a picture of the spiritual battle going on all the time? How are we able to find victory in the midst of the battles we encounter each day?
- Application: How is it true that each day we are faced with a choice to surrender to God or stand up to Him? What are some ways we try and fight God? And what does a life surrendered look like? Any area you need to surrender to Him rather than fight Him?
