

Community group questions
Luke 24:1-12

Opening question: Any special Easter traditions growing up or you have now?

Scripture study: Luke 24:1-12

- What are some confusing elements to the various perspectives of the resurrection story (you might want to read or skim through the other accounts in Mt 28:1-15; Mk 16:1-8; John 20:1-18)?
- Make some observations about the women's visit to the tomb in Luke 24:1-5. What were they expecting to see that left them wondering? How can confusion be a stage in the process of faith? How have you seen your faith grow in situations that don't fit your expectations?
- Read 24:6-8. How do these two men bring these women along towards believing? How does remembering His truths help us in all aspects of our lives? Give examples of times when remembering what God has said addressed a specific need in your life.
- Read 24:9-12. What is the significance of the women being eyewitnesses to the empty tomb? What important information does Luke 24:33-34 & I Corinthians 15:3-5 provide that we don't see in the resurrection accounts? Consider what Jesus' appearance might have meant to Mary Magdalene (John 20:10-18), the other women (Mt 28:8-10), and Peter.
- Any confusion or doubts or wondering you need to bring to the Lord?
- What are the implications of following a living person rather than a dead example?
