

Community group questions
Revelation 22:6-21

Opening question: What are positive words spoken to you that have stuck with you?

Scripture study

- Read Revelation 22:6-7. What words of assurance are given to John and the church? How do these verses speak to the point of the book of Revelation? What kind of blessing comes to those who keep the words of this book?
- Read Revelation 22:8-11. What are some things John is told not to do? How are verses 8-9 like 19:9-10? What is the significance of John being told not to seal up these words? What are personal challenges when it comes to getting word out about Jesus Christ?
- Read 22:12-17. How is verse 11 connected to verse 12? Who are the ones blessed (see also 7:9-14)? What are some ways Jesus describes himself in these verses? What invitation is given and how does it speak to our evangelism efforts?
- Read 22:18-21. What is the warning given and what are some contemporary ways that people “add” or “subtract” from God’s Word? See also Deuteronomy 12:32 & Joshua 1:6-8 for further insights to what we see here in Revelation. How is this a sobering reminder for us when it comes to the Word of God?
- Further Application: Three times Jesus speaks of coming soon (22:7, 12, 20). How should this impact our witness, our worship, our work, our values, our treatment of others, our time in God’s Word & prayer, our love for His church, etc? How might these last words of Jesus motivate you to persevere?
